



ITINERARY : DARJEELING WITH TAKDAH5N/6D EX – HWH/SDAH

DAY 1 : SEALDAH / HOWRAH – NJP TRAIN

Upon arrive Sealdah / Howrah Railway Station, meet and greet. Next board at train for NJP,
Meals : No Meals

DAY 2 : NJP – DARJEELING

Post breakfast check out from hotel and transfer to Darejeeling via Mirik. On the way visit Mirik, Gopaldhara, Lepchajagat. Evening visit mall and local market, at your own. Overnight at Darjeeling.
Meals : Lunch and Dinner

DAY 3 : DARJELLING LOCAL SIGHTSEEING

Early Morning at 0400 AM visit Tiger Hill famous for sunrise over Mt. Kanchendzonga, on way back visit Ghoom Monastery, Batasia Loop and back to hotel. After breakfast visit Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, PNZ Zoological Park (closed on Thursday) Tenzing Rock, Tibetan Refuge Centre (closed on Sunday), Tea Garden (outer view). Overnight Halt at Darjeeling.

DAY 4 : DARJEELING – TINCHULEY – LAMAHATTA - TAKDAH

Have breakfast and get ready for a sightseeing excursion to Lamahatta, Takdah and Tinchuley. Lamahatta is a breathtaking offbeat village attracts thousands of visitors every year due to offering a splendid view of Kanchenjunga and the other Himalayan Peaks. Visit Lamahatta Park and relish the beauty of the pine trees standing Majestically, Colourful Buddhist prayer flags, the scenic roadside garden etc. Next, visit Takdah which is another scenic village just about 10 km distance away from Lamahatta. After, enjoying the alluring atmosphere and a stunning show of nature, lastly, visit Tinchuley.

Tinchuley is a small hilly region just like the other two villages you have already explored. Tinchuley means three ovens and the village got its name because of the three hilltops that surround the settlement and look like an oven. From the village, you can trek through the lush green vegetation to reach Gumba Dara View Point. Here, you will have a fascinating glimpse of shimmering river Rangeet and a part of the Sikkim. Visit Tinchuley Monastery, several caves, Tinchuley View Point, etc. All of them offer unique phenomena of nature to enjoy. Overnight at Takdah.
